He came to Kedington
when his mother married
John Rice. Brewer 1851.
Lived at Dane House
1861, then built
Prospect House 1881.
Property owner.
Left £1,000 to
Kedington charities.
No issue

Arms, 1841-68,
Farmer of Cornish
Hall End, 1871
left approx. £1,000.

MARIA
c. 1824-1908
m. JOHN SARGEANT
(d. 1860)

Baker of Clare, 1851.
Lic. of Red Lion,
Finchingfield, 1859.
Maria was school
mistress at Kedington
1871, then baker
1874-81. Retired
to Respect Terrace.

JOHN
1830-1882
m. SUSAN

Farmer of Hall
Farm, brewer &
maltster of
Kedington.
Lived at White
House. Owner
of 840 acres
in 1871 including
Hempstead Estate.
Left £8,385.
His executors
sold the brewery,
maltings and
19 pubs, 1883.
Had issue, including -

1831-1894

Corn merchant of
