2. In the first column, write the *No.* of the *Schedule* you are about to copy, commencing with *No.* 1; in the second column the name of the Road, Street, Square, &c., in which the house is situated, and the *No.* of the *house*, or any distinctive name by which it is known; then insert in the third column the figure 1 for an Inhabited House, and copy from the Schedule into the other columns all the particulars concerning the persons returned therein, without any omission, or any abbreviation except those authorised in the Instruction at the foot of this page, taking especial care to enter the *ages* of MALES and of FEMALES in their PROPER COLUMNS.

Enter in the same manner the contents of all the other Schedules, in strict numerical order.

3.
