


Ansor Gallows Farm in Hempsted




Little Brockhalls Farm in Radwinter in the






Wood Hall Demeans & Farm in Finchingfield
in the Tenure of Thomas Legerton




Finchingfield Farm called the Boarded Barn

John Myhall




Hempsted Parsonage House and 3 ad 1 R.
